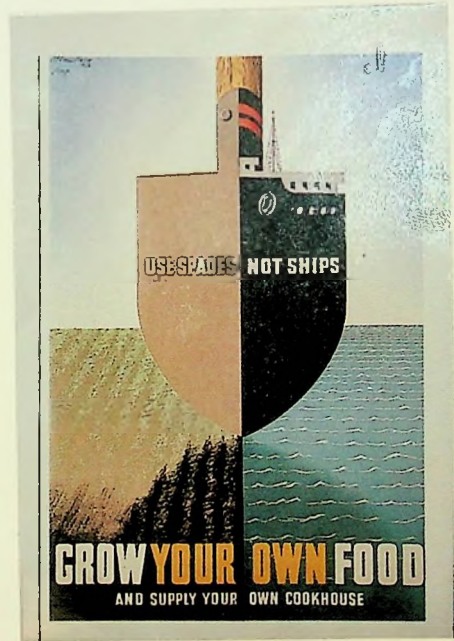


Figure: 1 'Grow Your Own Food.' – Abram Games

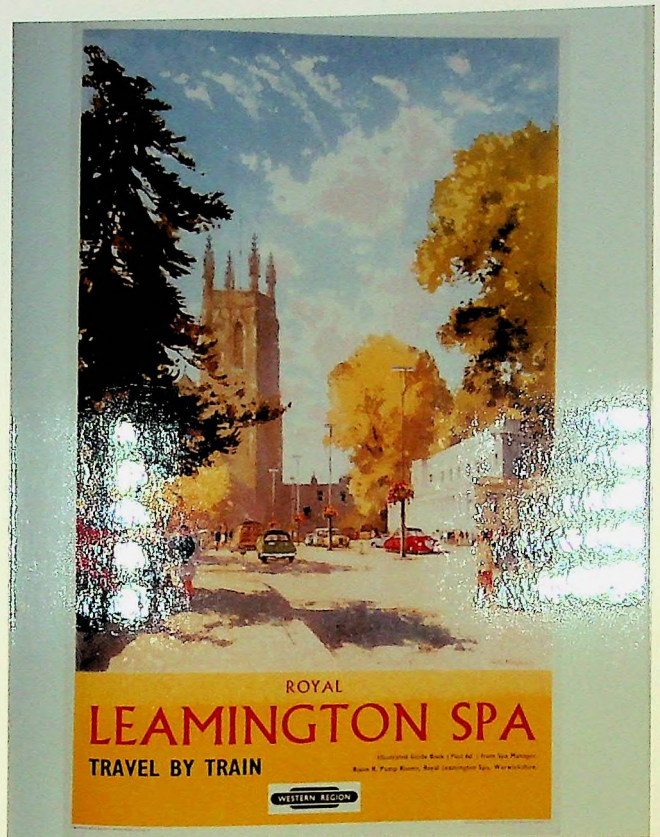


Figure 4 'Royal Leamington Spa.' – Jack Merriott

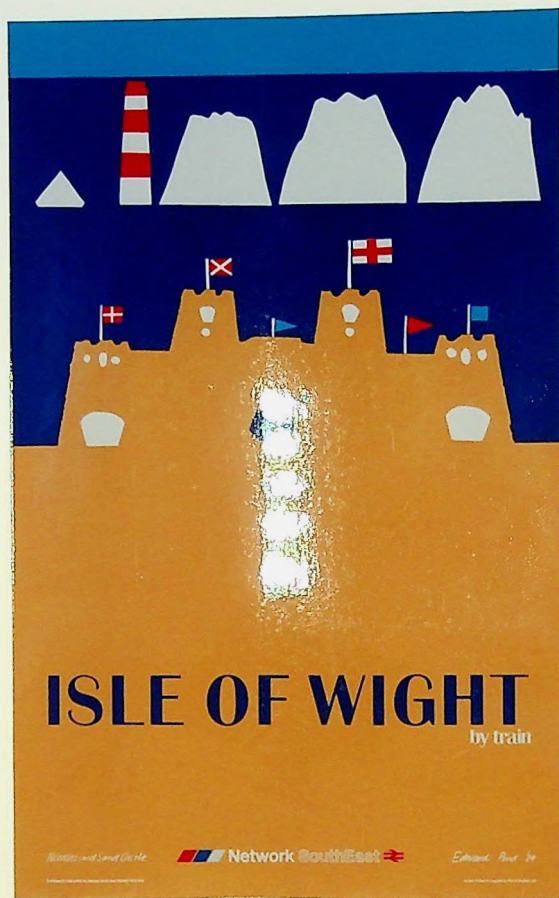
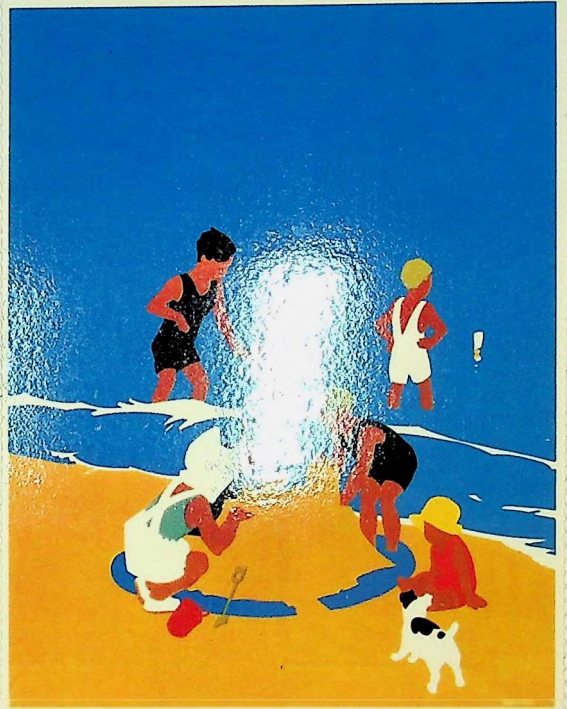


Figure 6 'Needles and Sandcastle, Isle of Wight.' — Pond

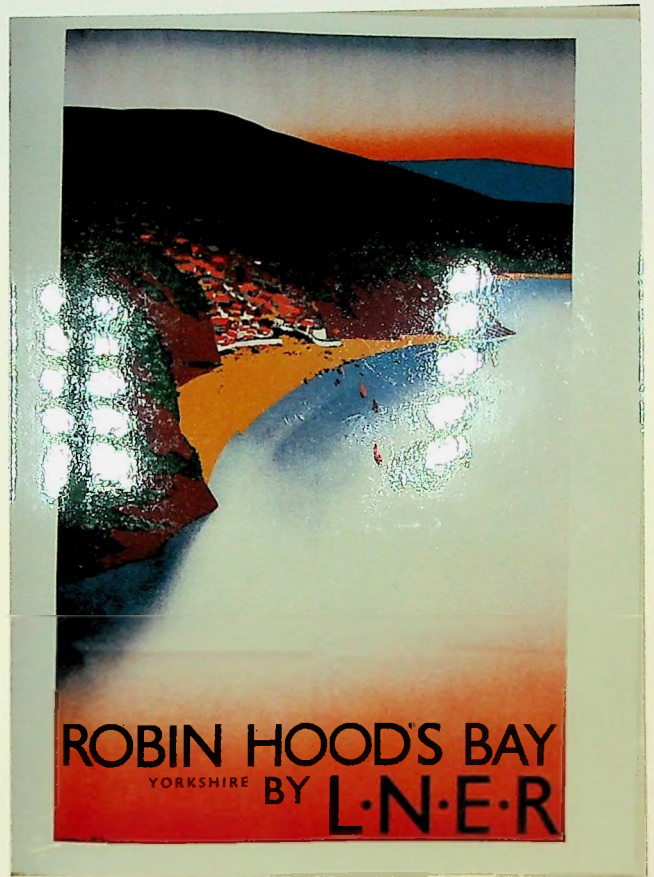


Figure 9 'Robin Hood's Bay.' -- Tom Purvis

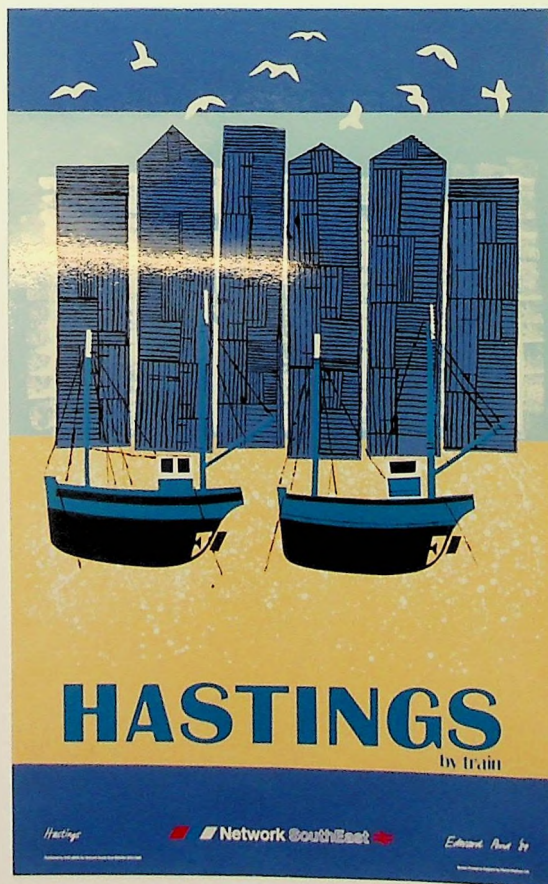


Figure 11 'Hastings' – Pond

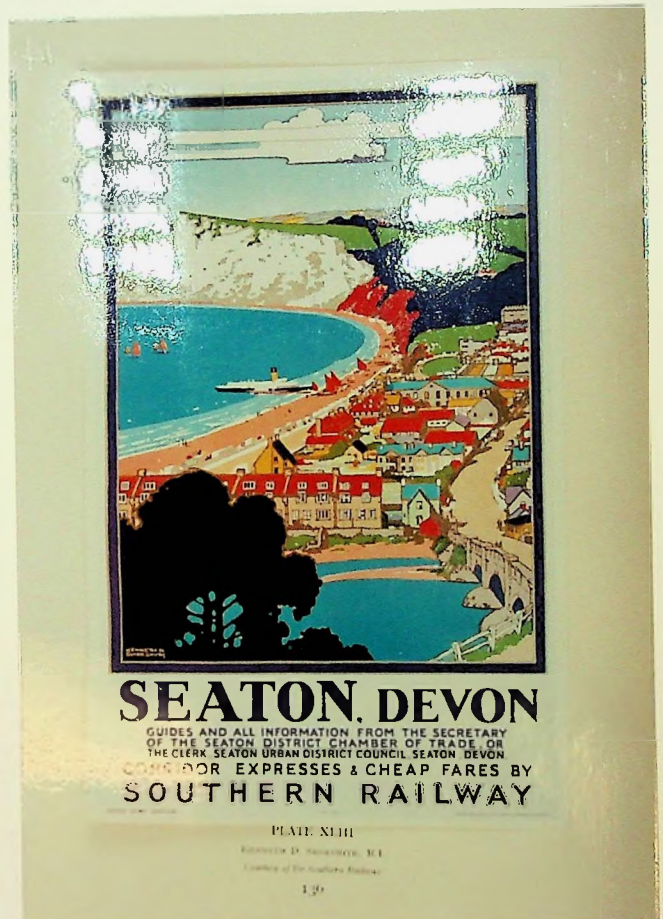


Figure 14 'Seaton, Devon.' – Kenneth D. Shoesmith

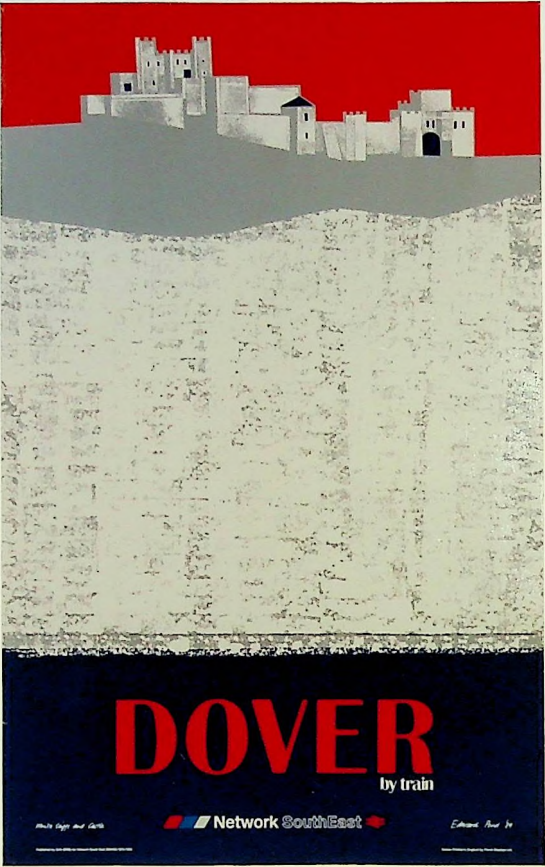


Figure 18 'Windsor Castle.' – Pond





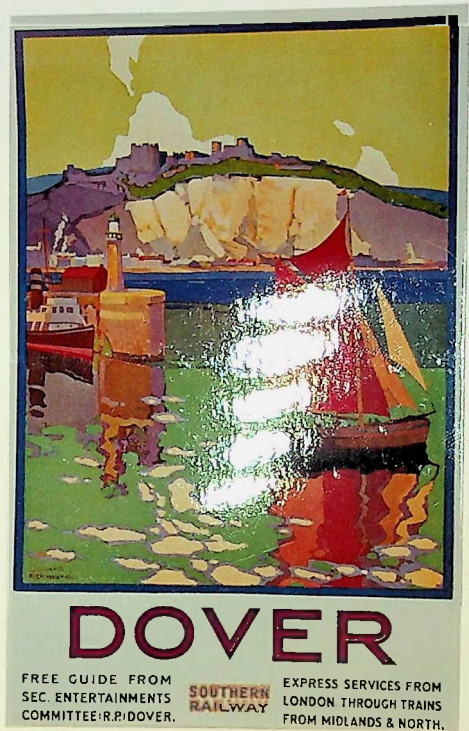


Figure 19 'Dover' – Leonard Richmond

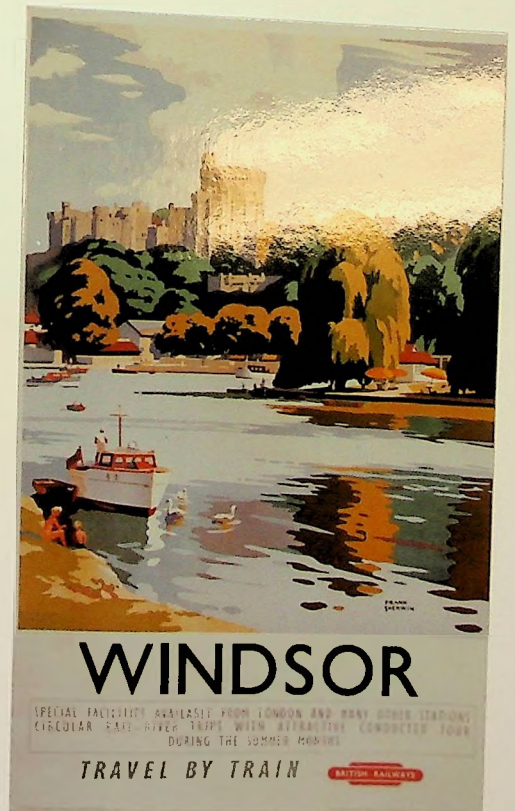


Figure 20 'Windsor.' – Frank Sherwin

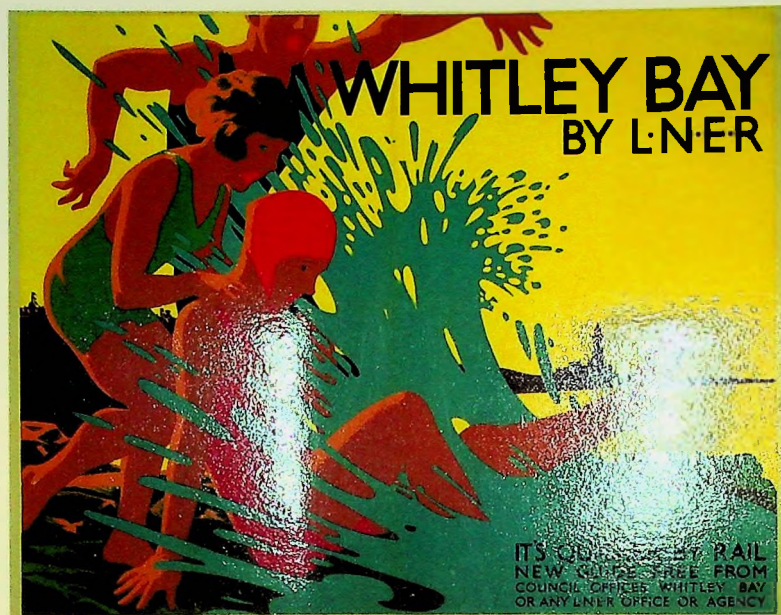


Figure 22 'Whitley Bay.' – Tom Purvis

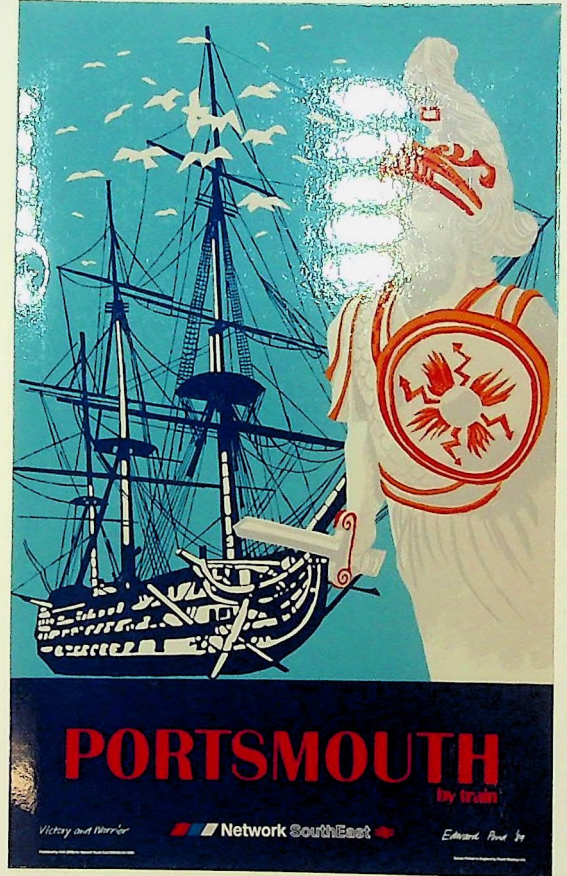


Figure 24 'Portsmouth, Victory and Warrior.' – Pond

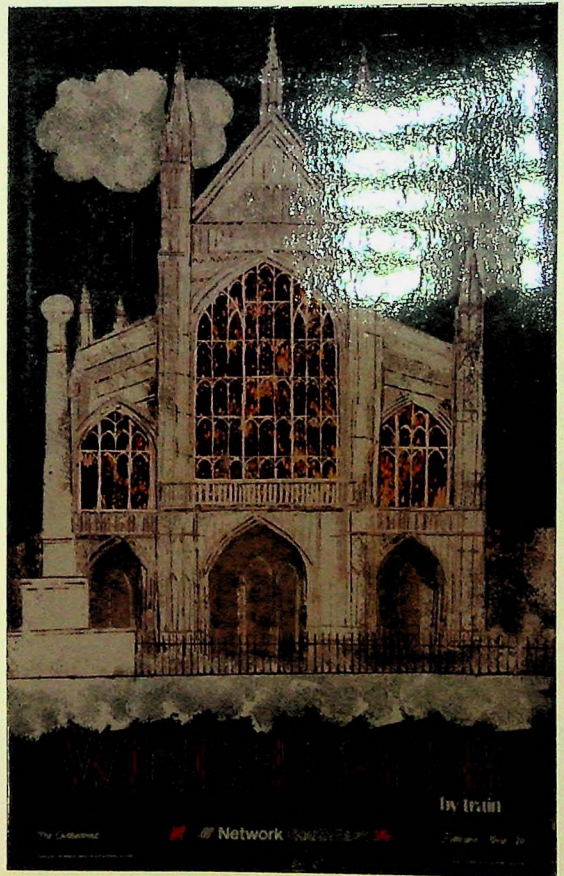


Figure 26 'Winchester, The Cathedral.' – Pond



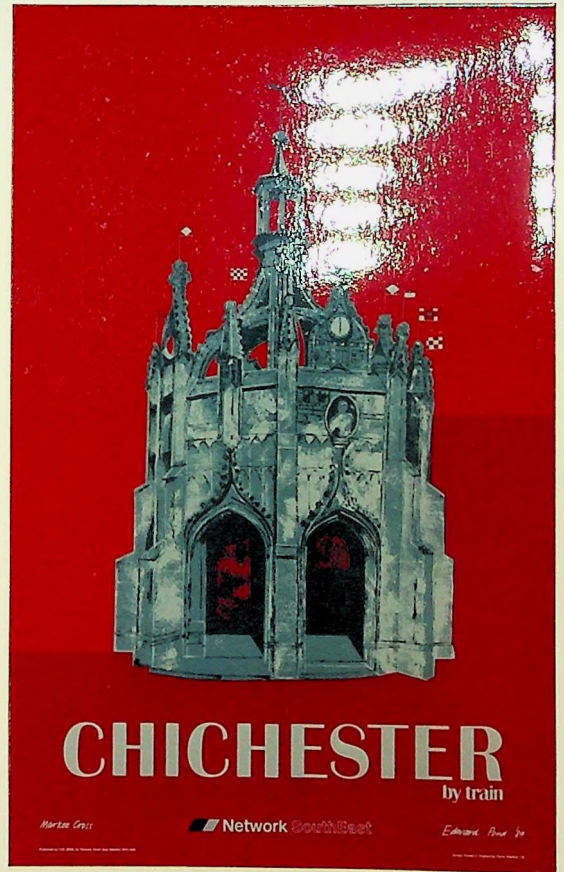


Figure 27 'Chichester, Market Cross' -- Pond

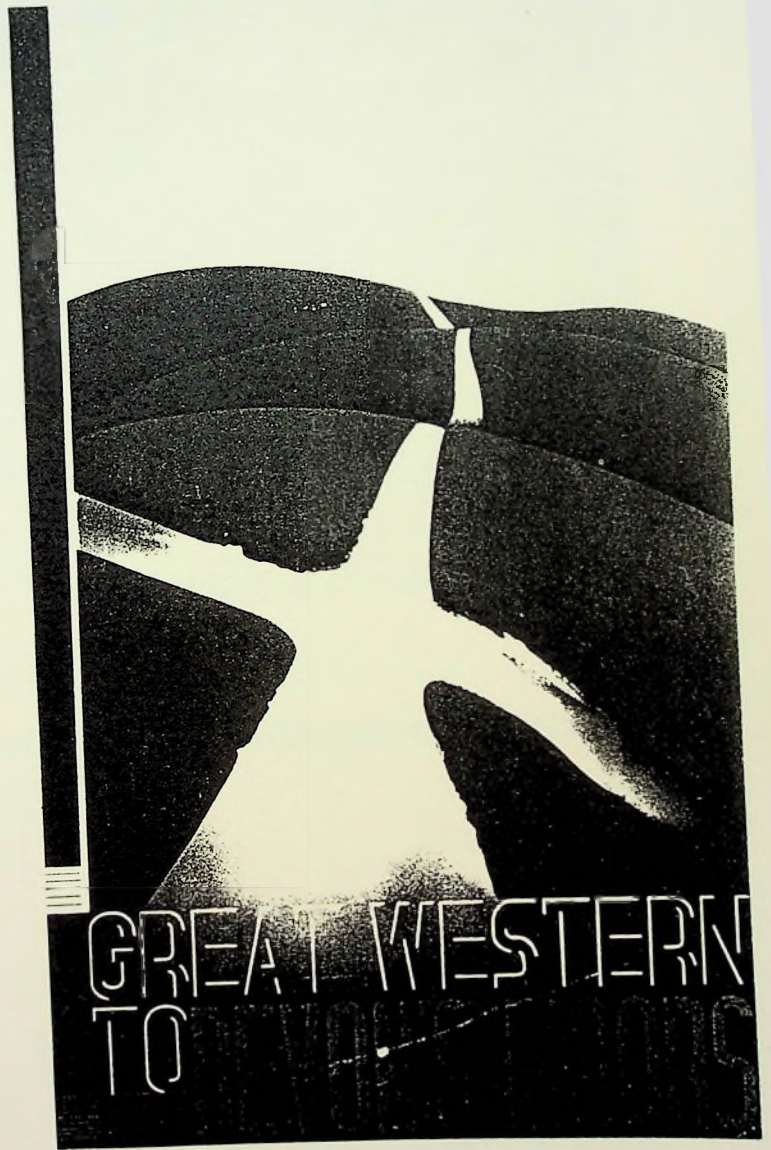


Figure 30 'Go Great Western to Devon's Moors.' — E.Mc Knight Kauffer

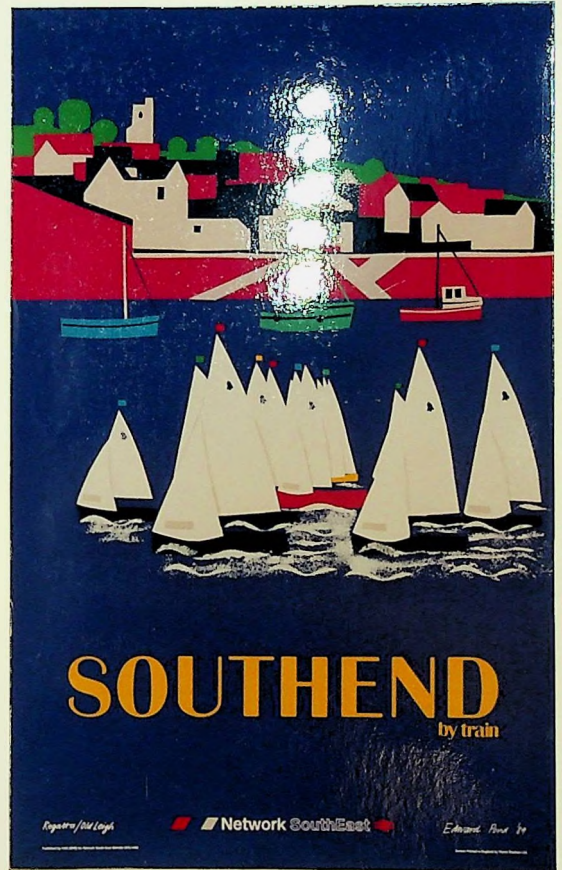


Figure 34 'Southend, Regatta/Old Leigh.' – Pond

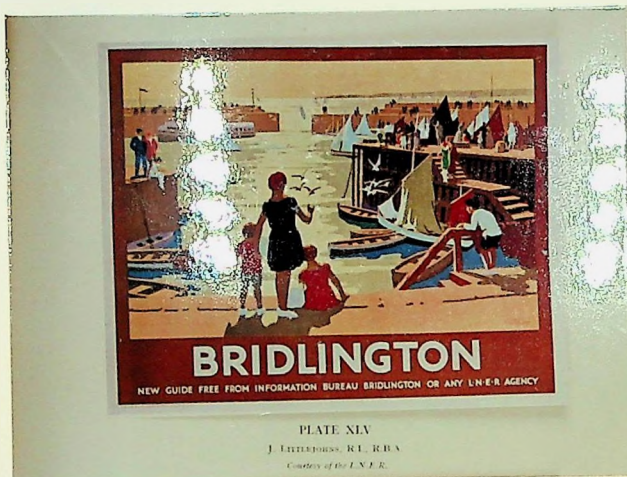


Figure 33 'Bridlington' - Littlejohn

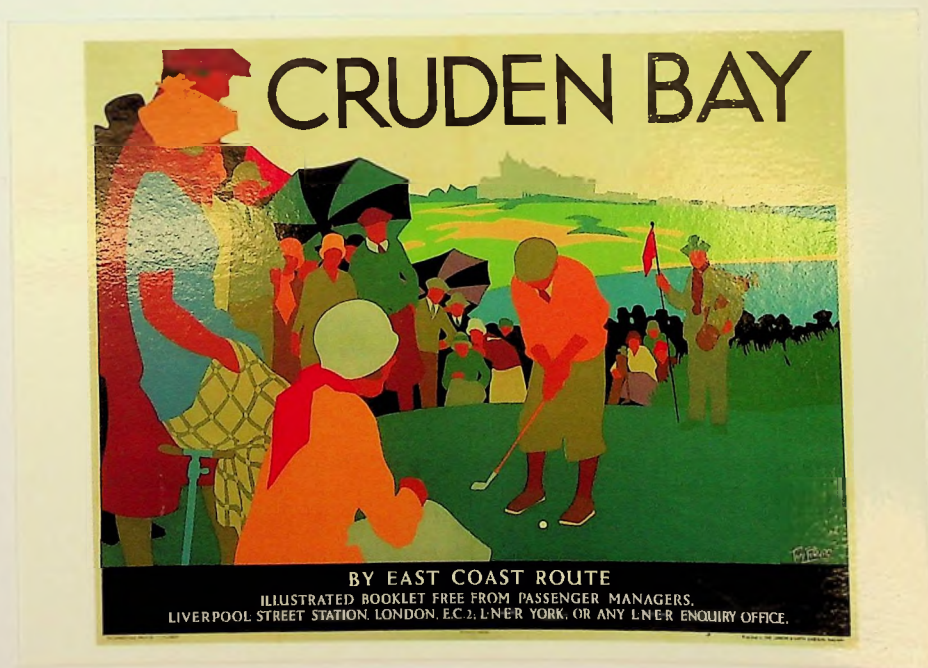


Figure 35 'Cruden Bay.' - Tom Purvis

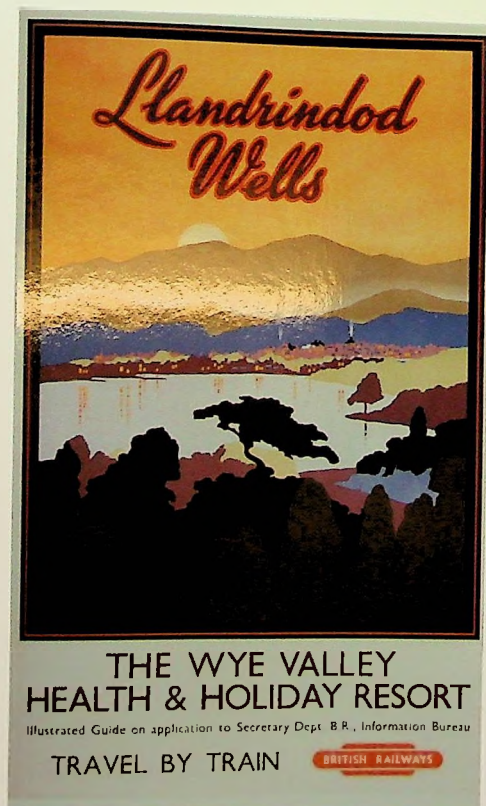


Figure 37 'Llandrindod Wells.' -- Artist Unknown



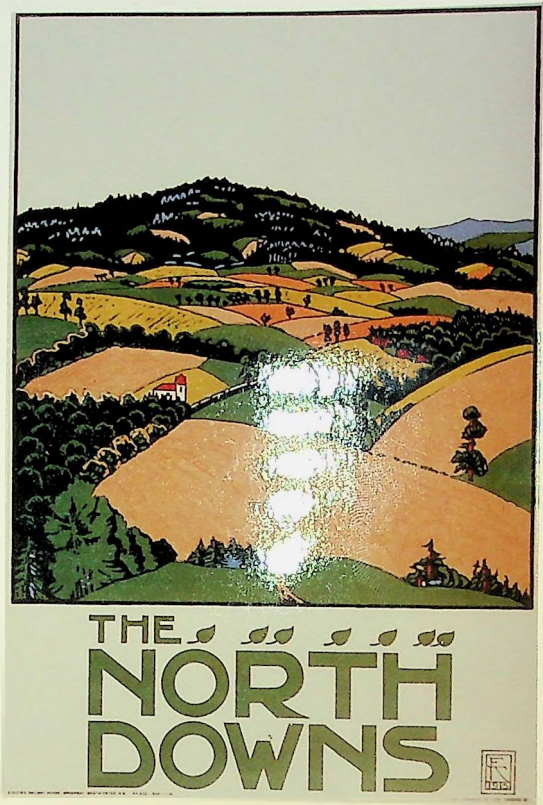


Figure 38 'The North Downs.' – E.Mc Knight Kauffer

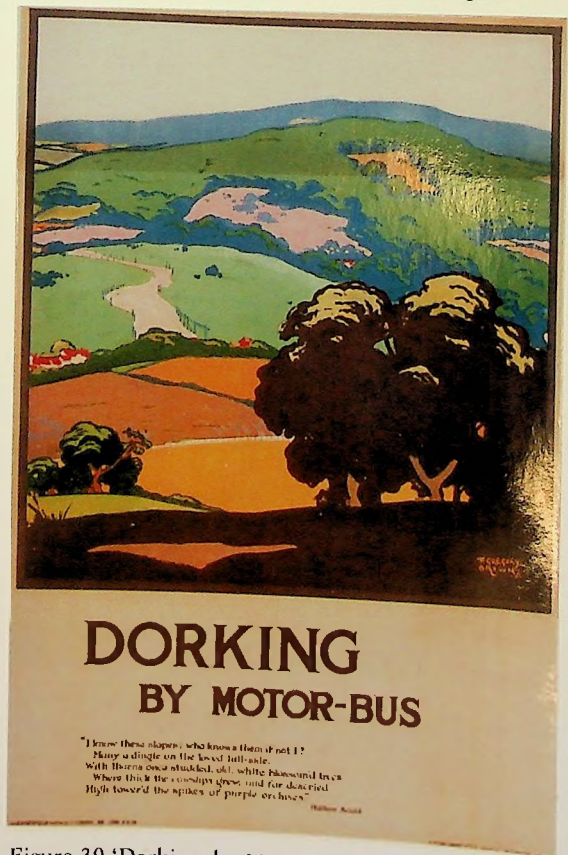


Figure 39 'Dorking by Motor-Bus.' – Gregory Brown

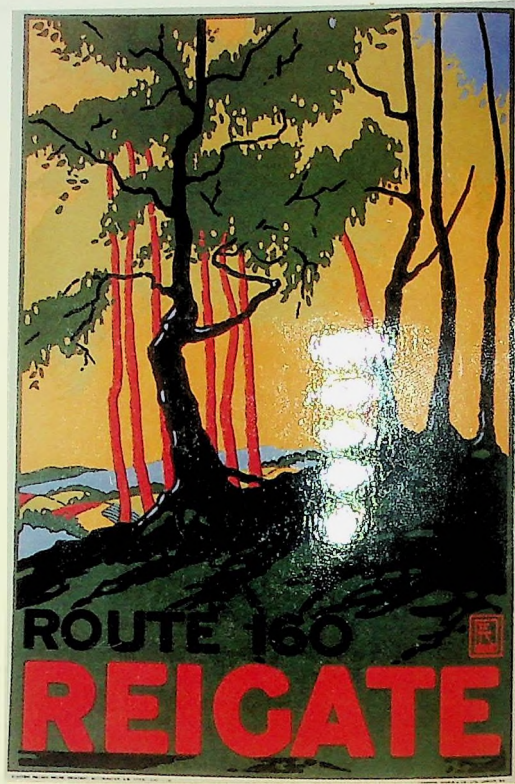


Figure 40 'Route 160, Reigate.' – E.Mc Knight Kauffer

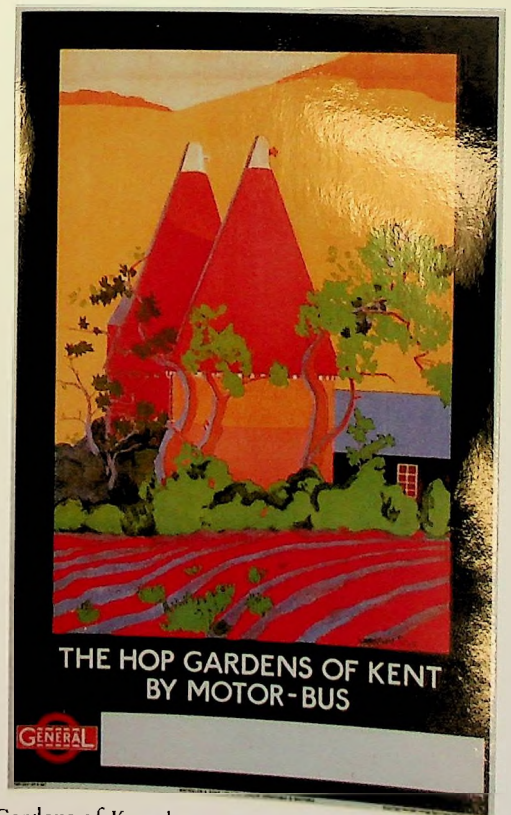
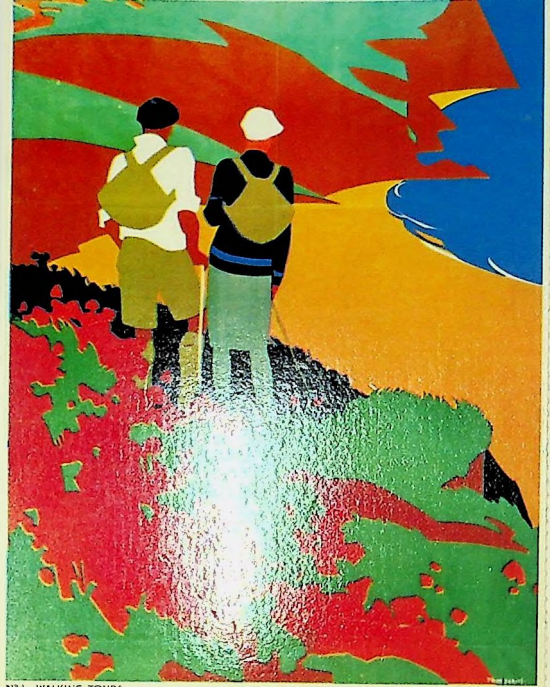


Figure 41 'The Hop Gardens of Kent by Motor-Bus.' – Dorothy Dix





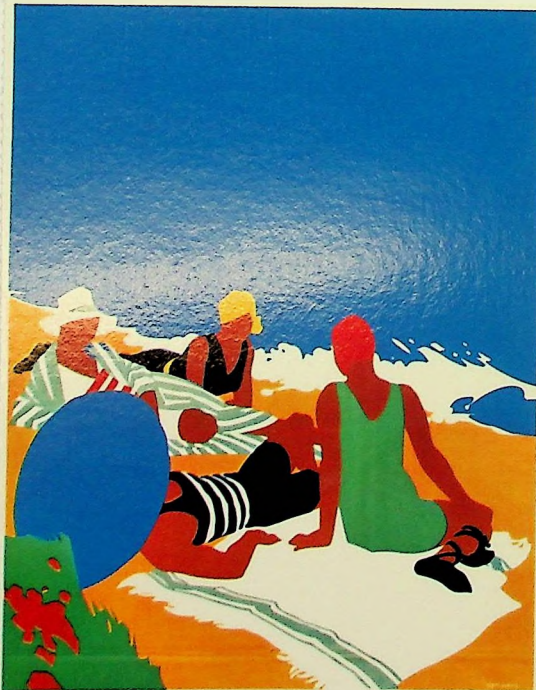

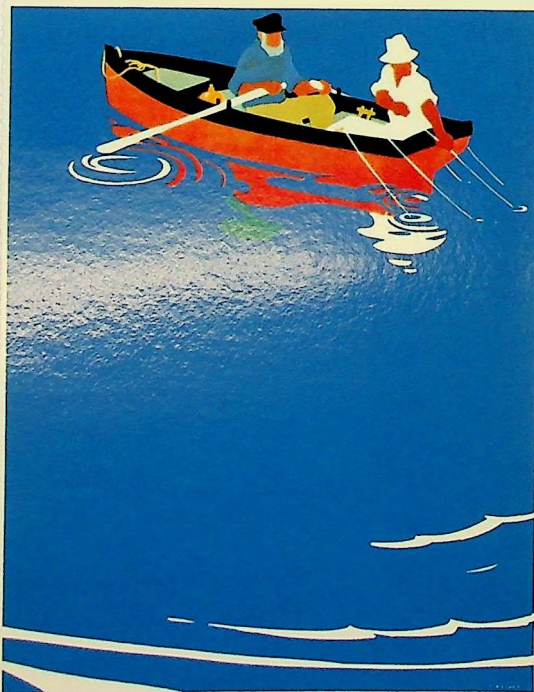
Figure 43 'Sun-Bathing.' – Tom Purvis

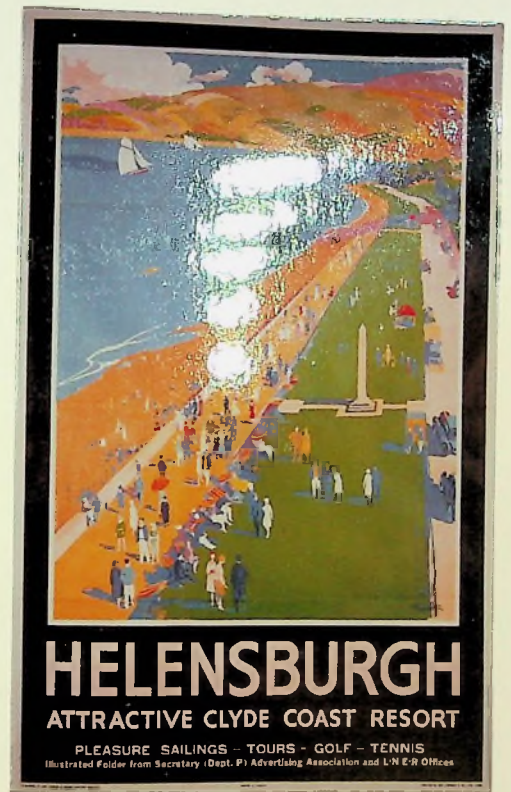


Figure 47 'Helensburgh,' Templeton

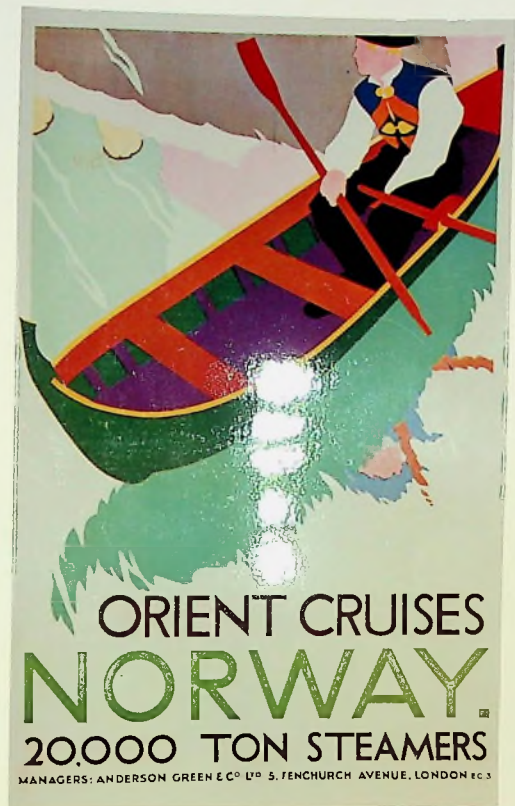


Figure 49 'Orient Cruises, Norway.' – Venables

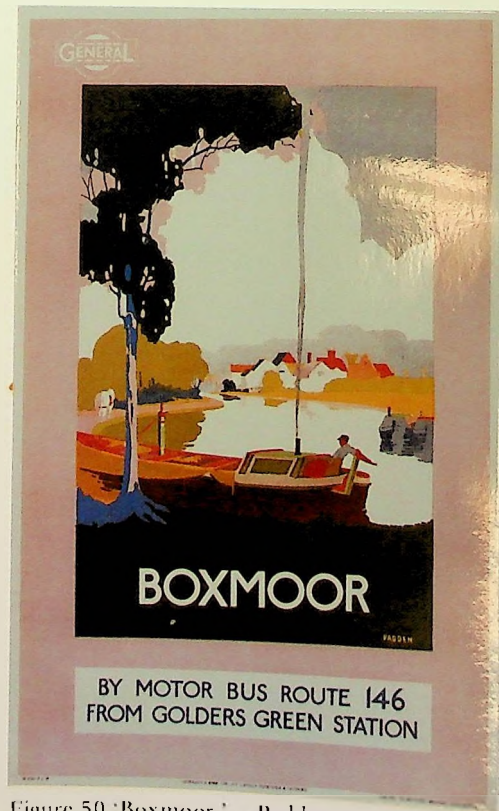


Figure 50 'Boxmoor.' – Padden
